The Astoria Police Department is inviting residents of the Alderbrook Neighborhood to a community-policing meeting on Saturday November 22<sup>nd</sup> at 5:00PM. The one hour meeting will be held at Alderbrook Hall which is located at the corner of Lief Erickson and 45<sup>th</sup> Street. Refreshments will be provided.

The Alderbrook neighborhood includes the area from 41<sup>th</sup> Street east, to Tongue Point, south to Commercial Street, and north to the river. Emerald Heights is not part of this area.

The meeting will be an opportunity to meet Astoria's new Police Chief Pete Curzon. Chief Curzon will be introducing himself to neighbors and discussing current issues members of the neighborhood are facing. Chief Curzon also plans to discuss the future form community policing will take in Astoria and obtain input from the community.

There will be short presentations on Identifying Drugs by Astoria Police Officer John Decker, and Seasonal Safety Issues by Astoria Fire Marshall Mike Jackson. The officer currently assigned to the neighborhood, Officer Andrew Randall, will also be available.
